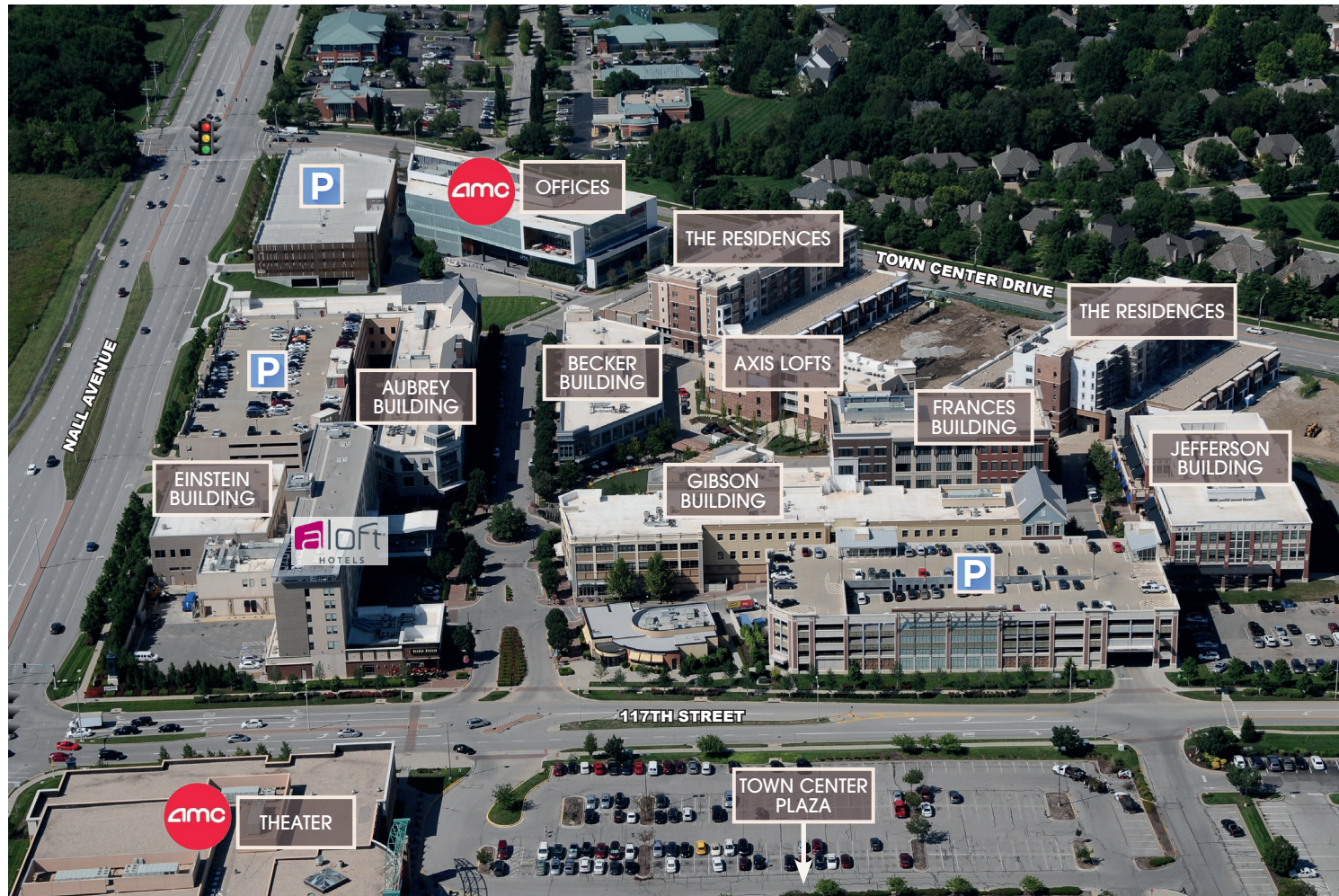

The City of Leawood

Leawood is home to many of the Kansas City area’s most upscale neighborhoods. With just over 34,000 residents in more than 13,000 households, the average home value is more than twice the metro average at \$703,263. Residents are well-educated and affluent, with more than 76% holding a Bachelor’s Degree and earning an average household income of more than \$254,000. The City is currently one of the fastest growing in the state of Kansas with an estimated 2,103 business establishments located in Leawood, which employ approximately 26,436 people.

Some of the best places to shop, dine and play in the Kansas City area are found in Leawood. The 119th Street and Nall intersection is the hottest retail corridor in the metro including notable local retail development Park Place Village. Restaurants include 801 Chophouse, RA Sushi, Verdigris, Bristol Seafood, Aixois, and Bamboo Penny’s. Leawood’s vibrant arts community adds to the quality of life for its residents and includes theater groups, musical ensembles, numerous outdoor concert series and children’s arts programming.
